Course Content

Every Child Can![®] is an introduction to Dr. Suzuki's philosophy and its application to Suzuki education. For parents, teachers, perspective teachers and others, this new course provides an inspiring, in-depth look at the Suzuki approach to teaching and learning. For teachers *ECC* serves as the required first course in the Suzuki Association of the Americas' Teacher Development Program. In addition to exploring the elements of the Suzuki approach and its far-reaching goals, it includes an introduction to learning styles, history of the development of Suzuki education, the role of parents, the importance of Suzuki pedagogical training, and an overview of the SAA's role in supporting teachers and parents. A fast-paced, engaging and inspiring program, *ECC* includes new video materials and SAA-developed courseware and provides each participant with useful reference materials for later study.
